

Commissioning Silverware

Commissioning a maker to make a piece especially for you can be a stimulating, exciting and rewarding experience. Commissions can vary from small, functional pieces to large, decorative objects. Kirsty accepts commissions for awards and trophies, corporate gifts, church silverware and commemorative objects as well as pieces for the home or individual. Whatever your need Kirsty will work with you to help realise your ideas and requirements and create the appropriate piece.

If you are interested in commissioning a unique Kirsty Eaglesfield piece here are some points you might like to consider before contacting her:

Budget:

 How much would you like to spend? A design and materials to be used are much easier to work out if a budget has been defined beforehand.
Remember that prices may vary according to the size, materials and complexity of the work involved.

Time scale:

- When would you like to receive the object?
- Is it for a specific occasion?
- Will you need it before the date of the occasion for photography etc?

Object:

- Do you want the object to have a specific function?
- Does it need to have a specific volume or capacity?
- Are there certain dimensions you would like the maker to stick to?
- Do you want a specific finish on the object's surface e.g. textured, polished, oxidised?

All these questions will be gone over in detail with you before the commission is started so don't worry if you want to discuss your options with the Kirsty before you make up your mind.
